

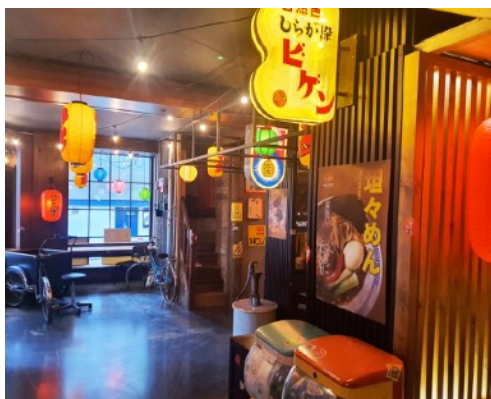
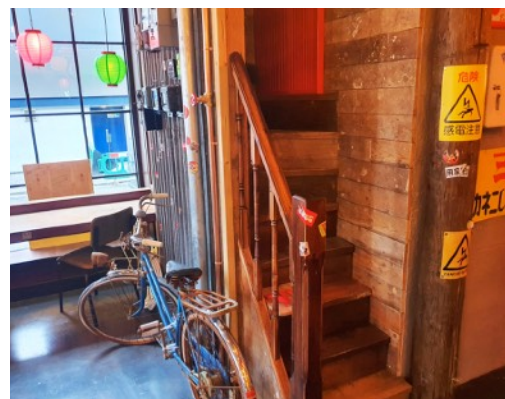
YOKOCHO PANTON



Yokochō, Japanese for an alleyway, are famous in the packed streets of Japan for their delicious restaurants, and this restaurant is no different.

This fit-out consisted of multiple items and design ideas ranging from old used telegraph poles, used ladders with hanging rice bowls, reeded screens and tables made from bottle crates to give that authentic theme. Additional designs included wooden roof slates over the kitchen serving areas, corrugated steel roofs and even internal windows bringing the outside in. With finishing touches of numerous paper lanterns and antique steel signs, this really does make you feel like you are in a 1970's Japanese inspired ramen bar.

A key feature within the fit-out is the abundance of Shou Sugi ban – and ancient Japanese carbonised wood finish, created by burning the surface of wood to preserve it.
