Ichiba London – reportedly Europe’s largest Japanese food hall and one of Bluecrow’s largest fit-outs to date, a gigantic, 17,400 sq ft blank canvas.

With all sections being bespoke built, a multitude of different materials were used to deviate one area to another. All surfaces and perimeter counter tops are finished in Terrazzo and fitted with under counter LED lighting.

Tiles ranged from chevron and hexagon timber tiles for the floor; marble tiles for the bakery worktop, shelving and counter cladding with concrete effect tiles for the kitchens and noodle bar facade.

European rustic oak was used for the joinery throughout. This can be seen on the freezer panelling, ceilings, shelving, fridges, and even the large bespoke ornamental Sake barrel.
